

## **Practice Direction 1 of 2015**

## **Registration of Building Appeals Board Determinations**

## Purpose:

To provide directions on how to register Building Appeals Board determinations in the Magistrates' Court of Victoria pursuant to section 19 of Schedule 3 of the *Building Act 1993*.

## **Registration of a Building Appeals Board Determination**

An applicant to whom payment is to be made under a determination made by the Building Appeals Board may enforce the order by filing:

- 1. a true copy of the Building Appeals Board Determination; and
- 2. an 'Affidavit in Support of Enforcement of Determination' (copy attached).

No charge is to be made for filing a determination and an affidavit in support of enforcement of the determination.

On registration of the determination, the determination is taken to be an order of the Magistrates' Court and may be enforced accordingly.
