INFORMATION SHARING CONSENT FORM (Adult Only)

Part 5A of the *Family Violence Protection Act 2008* provides a legislative basis for prescribed information sharing entities to request and share information to assess and manage family violence risks.

Why information sharing is important.

Information Sharing is important for relevant services to work together to keep perpetrators in view and keep you (and if applicable, your children) safe. Information will only be shared where it is necessary to assess and manage the risks of family violence. Your information will not be shared with the respondent at any time.

Why am I being asked to fill out this consent form?

The Court requires your consent to share confidential information about you with other prescribed Information Sharing Entities (ISEs) for the purpose of assessing your risk, or for the purpose of managing your ongoing safety.

Please note in cases of a serious threat or where your information is linked to assessing and/or managing the family violence risk to a child, the law permits information to be shared about any person without consent.

The court will endeavour to seek your consent prior to sharing any information that is it is legally authorised to share. However, in the event that the collection, use or disclosure of confidential information is necessary to lessen or prevent a serious threat to an individual's life, health, safety or welfare, your consent will not be requested.

Consent

- Your consent will allow the Magistrates' Court of Victoria to share your confidential information with other ISEs (unless specified), for the purposes of assessing and managing family violence risk. Refer to the back of this form for a list of ISEs.
- Your information will <u>not</u> be shared with the respondent named in your application and it will be held securely by the Court.
- You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time.
