Examples of collateral or ulterior purposes are using the information in different proceedings; using the material for a business reason; or disclosing the information to people or entities unrelated to the proceeding.
- All recipients of the material are subject to the undertaking and will only be released from it
 with leave of the court or through publication of the material in open court.
- Your access is also subject to the terms of the access order made by the Magistrates' Court
 of Victoria in relation to the material.
- Breach of this undertaking or the access order may constitute a contempt of Court.
