Practice Direction 4 of 2021

Silent Listings

1. This Practice Direction revokes Practice Direction 3 of 2014
2. Unless a proceeding is part-heard before a Magistrate, all applications for a silent listing of a criminal proceeding must be made to the Chief Magistrate and when he or she is unavailable, a Deputy Chief Magistrate or the Head of the Criminal Division;
3. The application must be accompanied by an affidavit setting out the basis for making the application for a silent listing;
4. The application and the affidavit in support must be filed at the Magistrates' Court at Melbourne with the Senior Registrar
5. This Practice Direction commences on 23/9/21
