## **NOTICE TO VICTORIA POLICE**

An application to extend a support and engagement order must not be made after the order has expired. If the application for an extension is made before the order has expired, but the order subsequently expires while the extension application is pending, the order will continue to operate until the court has determined the extension application, or the order has been in effect for two years (whichever occurs first).

A supported person may not be subject to a support and engagement order for more than two years. If this application to extend is not finalised when the supported person has been subject to one or more orders for two years, the order ceases to have effect.

Any counter-terrorism intelligence protection application in relation to this application to extend must be made within 3 days after this application is made. Once the counter-terrorism intelligence protection application has been determined, Victoria Police should advise the Court of the outcome of that application and provide a copy of any order made.

## NOTICE TO THE RESPONDENT

If you are a child - Children **must** be legally represented during these proceedings. You should immediately seek advice from your lawyer. If you do not have a lawyer, you can call Victoria Legal Aid's Youth service on (03) 9269 0108 for free legal advice and representation.

If you are an adult - Adults can be legally represented during these proceedings. You should immediately seek advice from your lawyer.
