### Unit Value

### Exemptions

Proceedings under the *Maintenance Act 1965*, *Family Violence Protection Act 2008* and *Personal Safety Intervention Orders Act 2010* are exempt from payment of any fees set by the Magistrates' Court (Fees) Regulations 2022.

The following are exempt from the payment of fees in the criminal jurisdiction only, Part 1 and 3.1 - 3.4 (left):

- A police officer acting in the course of the police officer's duty;
- A person acting for or by authority of the Crown (Victoria); a person acting for or by authority of the Secretary;
- A person acting for or by authority of a municipal council where the proceeding relates to public health;
- A Business Licensing Authority established under Part 2 of the *Business Licensing Authority Act 1998*;
- A person who is serving a sentence of imprisonment or is otherwise detained in a detention facility;
- A person represented under a pro bono scheme administered by or on behalf of the Victorian Bar, the Law Institute of Victoria, Justice Connect or by a member of the Federal of Community Legal Centres Vic;
- A person who is under the age of 18 years.
- A person who has been granted legal aid established by a law of the Commonwealth or of a State or Territory;
- An inspector or person authorised under s24ZW of the *Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1986*, acting in the course of the inspector's duty;

The following matters are exempt from the payment of fees by other Acts:

- Any summons issued to answer a charge for an offence under the *Summary Offences Act 1966* (s56(2))
- Issuing of any process on behalf of an accused (s417 *Criminal Procedure Act 2009*) (this includes any summons, witness summons etc)

## Civil fee payer categories

### Who pays the standard fee rate?

People and businesses who pay the standard rate include:

- individuals
- sole trader businesses
- businesses set up as a partnership
- businesses with a turnover of less than \$200,000 in the last financial year
- not-for-profit organisations
- the executor or administrator of a deceased estate

If a company believes that they are a standard fee payer and they are filing by email, they need to complete the 'MCV Fee Payer Statement' with their fee document to state their turnover is less than \$200,000.

### Who pays the corporate fee rate?

Businesses with a turnover of more than \$200,000 in the last full financial year pay the corporate fee rate.

For example, if a fee document is filed in April 2024, use the turnover from the 2022/2023 financial year.

Schools and government organisations are part of this fee category.

### Who pays the concession fee rate?

Fees are lower for Health Care Card holders issued by the Commonwealth Government. This is the only card accepted for concession fees.



If the fee payer has another type of concession card, they are not entitled to the concession rate, but may be eligible for a fee waiver.
